Description	AJUBA (Ajuba LIM Protein) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with AJUBA include Wil son-Turner X-Linked Mental Retardation Syndrome and Bjornstad Syndrome. Among its related pathways are Hippo signaling pathway and Regulation of PLK1 Activity at G2/M Transition. Gene Ontology (GO) annotations related to this gene include chromatin binding and actin filament binding. An important paralog of this gene is WTIP.
