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GENE INFORMATION

Description	ARFIP2 (ADP Ribosylation Factor Interacting Protein 2) is a Protein Coding gene. Diseases associated with ARFIP2 include Silver-Russell Syndrome 1 and Gastric Papillary Adenocarcinoma. Among its related pathways are Vesicle-mediated transport and Cytoskeleton remodeling_Role of PDGFs in cell migration. Gene Ontology (GO) annotations related to this gene include GTP binding and Rac GTPase binding. An important paralog of this gene is ARFIP1.
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
