## GENE INFORMATION

<b>Alternative Names</b>	CEACAM1; BGP; BGP1; BGPI
<b>Description</b>	This gene is a protein coding gene. This gene encodes a member of the carcinoembryonic antigen (CEA) gene family, which belongs to the immunoglobulin superfamily. Two subgroups of the CEA family, the CEA cell adhesion molecules and the pregnancy-specific glycoproteins, are located within a 1.2 Mb cluster on the long arm of chromosome 19.
