Description	This gene is a protein coding gene. Exhibits PDZ domain binding activity; metalloendopeptidase activity; and signaling receptor binding activity. Involved in several processes, including positive regulation of cell migration; regulation of signal transduction; and response to bacterium. Localizes to several cellular components, including apical plasma membrane; cell surface; and membrane raft. Colocalizes with cell-cell junction; focal adhesion; and ruffle membrane. Implicated in Alzheimer's disease; inflammatory bowel disease; and type 2 diabetes mellitus. Biomarker of renal fibrosis.
